Community Forests: Supporting local resource management and vibrant communities

A community forest can be described as any forestry operation managed by a local government, a partnership, First Nation or community-held corporation, society or cooperative for the benefit of the entire community.

Community forestry embodies the four pillars of sustainable development: social, ecological, cultural, and economic sustainability. At its essence, it promotes local stewardship and equitable access to the benefits derived from nearby forest resources.

The membership of the BCCFA represents over 100 Indigenous and rural communities.

TRADE SHOW EXHIBITORS

Hosting a Trade Show exhibitor booth at the BCCFA Conference & AGM is an excellent opportunity to connect with delegates and display your organization's priority materials.
