# Ministry is Focused on Increasing Forest Sector Stability

- The Working Landscape (Formally the Working Forest)
- Forest Landscape Planning
- The Road Ahead (formally the Path to 45)
- Forecasting Future Timber Supply
- Keeping AACs Current



# Who Sets the AAC for Community Forest Agreements (CFAs)?

- Chief or Deputy Chief Forester for CFAs over 100,000 m<sup>3</sup>/yr
  - Chief Forester can Subdelegate to the Regional Executive Director or Director of Forest Analysis and Inventory Branch
- Regional Executive Director for CFAs under 100,000 m<sup>3</sup>/yr
  - Regional Executive Director can Subdelegate to the District Manager or Director of Forest Analysis and Inventory Branch



# When do AACs for CFAs need to be Redetermined?

- Management regime changes significantly
- New information indicates the AAC need Updating
- Length of time since the AAC was determined
- Significant Disturbance Occurs in the CFA
- Land is removed or added to the CFA
